- **President** Cheryl Pence Wolf

- Treasurer Jessica Young (treasury report)

Committee Reports

- Awards Kelly Bodurtha & Mandi Hancock
 - Mandi Hancock and Kelly Bodurtha are going to order plaques for the Beta Chapter award winners. They need to discuss funding and ordering with Jessica Young, Whitney Nobles (former awards chair), and Dr. Andrea Dixon. There will need to be a vote for the cost and the presentation will be at the Beta Chapter initiation ceremony in April.
 - First time conference grant applications will be announced in February. Those who have not previously attended a conference in the past can apply and receive funding for registration fees. These awards cover possible conferences from March 2010 to March 2011.

 - Moving to the hallway in Counselor Ed and it needs to be updated by the NCATE/Florida DOE reaccreditation visit on February 8-9, 2010.

 - Cheryl Pence Wolf took a vote of members who were interested in purchasing the banner. One voted in favor. All others voted against. Motion to purchase the banner denied.

 - About 25-28 graduates and 75-80 of people attended in the Terrace Room where CSI Beta Chapter bought refreshments. The CSI Beta Chapter-sponsored graduation ceremonies are valuable to graduating students and their families and should continue with our support.

- Fall 2010 Admissions
 - Isabel Thompson is working on the admission files and the interviews will be held February 22nd from 10-12 for M.Ed./Ed.S. candidates. Assistance is needed to help set up from 11:00-11:30.
 - February 11-13th Ph.D. interviews and series of events to take place.
