**Officer Reports**

- **President**                      Cheryl Pence Wolf
  - Introduction of all members present at the meeting because there were three new members present.
  
- **President Elect**        Ryan Reese
  - Poll to see who is attending ACA for transportation/lodging reasons.
  
- **Secretary**                      Kelly Bodurtha filled in for Carrie Swango
  - Approval of previous minutes: Cheryl Pence Wolf moved to approve meeting minutes from January 11, 2010. Trevor Kolski seconded. All in favor. The minutes were approved unanimously.
  
- **Treasurer**                      Jessica Young (treasury report)
  - Account balance of \$1230.70.
  - Jessica Young is willing to work with Adrienne Darnell on Fundraising.

**Committee Reports**

- **Awards**                              Kelly Bodurtha & Mandi Hancock
  - First time conference grant deadline was February 15, 2010.
  - Only one person has applied, but has already attended previous conferences. Further discussion needed with the faculty advisor to expand the guidelines and allow other attendees, rather than only first-time conference participants.
  - Cheryl Pence Wolf will work with Dr. Dixon, Mandi Hancock and Kelly Bodurtha on determining the expanded guidelines and new deadline for the conference grant.



- Bulletin Board Ashley Johnson, Kelly Bodurtha & Mandi Hancock
  - Bulletin board has been completed and may be further specialized for Chi Sigma Iota.
  
- Community Service Arianne Smith, Nikole Duvall
  - First community service event (Rebuilding Together) scheduled for January 30<sup>th</sup> was cancelled due to rain. but there was a show of 21 people planning on attending
  - Ana Jaramillo is planning another event on March 20, 2010 where participants take a three-hour class, learn about therapy for children with disabilities and spread the word about defects among children. There is interest from 21 students to participate. This activity has a promotional free pass to Disney World for those who volunteer.
  - Project makeover is going to be held on February 27, 2010 at Williams Elementary School helping them renovate their campus.
  - Community Service goal is to hold at least five events this semester.
  - Ana Jaramillo and Emily Campbell would like to participate in Relay for Life as another community service activity. There is a \$100 entrance fee and money raised for this will need to come from those who are participating or their sponsors.
  
- Fundraising Lauren Schommer, Adrienne Darnell
  - T-Shirt Contest: Three designs to be considered. One design was vetoed (Top 10 Reasons to Date a Counselor). The ideas were not approved. Other shirt ideas included something simple but professional... potentially "University of Florida Counselor Education on the left pocket with a Gator and CSI on the sleeve.
  - Shirts must be professional and represent the department and CSI well to people outside the program if CSI Beta is to fund it.
  - Possibly design a shirt outside of the contest with a combination of ideas. Cheryl Pence Wolf will work with Adrienne Darnell and the rest of the Fundraising Committee to develop an idea.
  - Kickball Fundraiser to be possibly held on March 28, 2010. But Adrienne Darnell will be out of town and proposed other dates (April 11 & 18) It is important to advertise and promote this event.
    - Potential winners may receive a free pizza or dinner out.
    - After the event all participants could go out to eat.
  - Disney Day from Community Service could hold a raffle for fundraising. This may not work because we are raising money for someone else, and not for Chi Sigma Iota.



- Membership Trevor Kolski
  - Trevor Kolski is informing people that they should join Chi Sigma Iota, but they do not have to head committee.
  - An event is being held this month such as skating or paintball. Dates will be emailed out before the next meeting.
  - Cheryl Pence Wolf encourages people to recruit members for their own committees.
  
- Newsletter Lynn Fairchild, Tracie Rogers
  - Tracie Rogers has spoken to several people about writing articles for the newsletter. Possibly have a student spotlight section.
  - There needs to be a deadline for submitting articles so there is enough time for editing. April 2, 2010 is the prospective early deadline for submitting an article. A later deadline can be considered for events after that date, such as the professional development conference, and the initiation ceremony.
  
- Professional Dev Ana Jaramillo, Laura Barbieri & Emily Campbell
  - The professional development conference will be held on April 9, 2010. Three rooms in Norman Hall have been reserved for presentations: 1327 A and B and the Terrace Room.
  - The initiation ceremony will be held on the same day, after the conference, potentially around 4pm.
  - Students were encouraged to present something they are interested in and may have written a paper on or would like to facilitate a discussion on. Formal published research is not required.
  
- Social Justice Adrienne Baggs & Angela Calderon
  - FRIENDS training Wednesday February 17, 2010 from 5-8pm. There are limited spaces available and nine people are attending so far. A few spaces remain.
    - Three hour training on LGBTQ Training to become aware of the issues of children who are coming out. The first hour is learning the language and is held in the Counselor Education department. Additionally there will be a panel discussion of personal experiences.
  - Important for people to show up to support professional development.
  - The migrant workers have a full schedule and cannot do another event for CSI outside of their other classroom visits.
  - Another event Angela Calderon is working on may involve the Harvest of Hope.



- Wellness Elisa Mott
  - Yoga and Jazz Night – was held at Leonardo's 706 and the Sanctuary and had a few people in attendance.

#### New Business

- Nominations & Elections coming up in early March 2010
  - Nominations and Elections are coming up and people are encouraged to step up and participate. There will be a vote for the President-Elect, Secretary and the Treasurer. If Ryan Reese leaves UF then someone else will have to be elected into the President position as well.
  - The new president will appoint committee leaders but people are encouraged to think about the roles they would like to take.
